



<p><b>Each day</b> read a book for 20 minutes. <b>(IN)</b></p> <p><b>Monday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make your own spelling list with 15 words from the books you are reading. Choose words that challenge you. Write them using a different colour for each of the vowels. (A,E,I,O,U). Circle the words that have a short vowel sound. <b>(IN)</b></li> <li>Choose 3 words from your spelling list. Write each in a sentence using past, present and future tense. <b>(SA)</b></li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Example: Dance</b></p> <p>She <b>danced</b> on the stage. (past) She <b>dances</b> on the stage. (present) She <b>will dance</b> on the stage. (future)</p> <p><b>Tuesday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Try to find a common noun beginning with every letter of the alphabet in your home. E.g. to the right of, behind, in front. <p><b>Each day</b> read a book for 20 minutes. <b>(IN)</b></p> <p><b>Wednesday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Use 8 of the noun groups you created yesterday to write sentences. Write a minimum of 3 complex sentences. <b>(IN)</b></li> <li>○ Watch <a href="#">Pearl Barley &amp; Charlie Parsley</a>. Write 5 things that are different between Pearl Barley &amp; Charlie Parsley in this text. Write 3 things that are different between you and your friend. <b>(GC)</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Thursday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Copy your spelling words that you created on Monday. Now write them in alphabetical order. <b>(SA)</b></li> <li>○ Watch the <a href="#">Prefixes and Suffixes</a> video. Add prefixes or suffixes to as many of your spelling words as possible. e.g happy = happier, happiest, happily, unhappy <b>(IN)</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Friday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Watch any <a href="#">BTN</a> story and write 3 quiz questions and their answers. Ask someone at home if they can answer your quiz questions. <b>(SA)</b></li> <li>○ Last week was the ‘Olympic Opening Ceremony’ in Japan. Make a list of 10 things you know about Japan or what you think you did see in the opening ceremony. <b>(IN)</b></li> </ul>	<p><b>Each day</b> complete the <a href="#">Daily 10 Mental Maths Challenge</a></p> <p><b>Wednesday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Create a 3-digit number by rolling your dice. Use short division to divide by 2, now try to divide the same 3-digit number by 3 and then by 5. <b>(IN)</b></li> <li>○ Number Talk - Write down everything you know about the number 255. E.g. It is an odd number, <math>200+55</math>. <b>(IN)</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Thursday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Draw five right angles, five angles larger than a right angle, and five angles smaller than a right angle. <b>(GC)</b></li> <li>○ How many ways can you make 1250? Use any operation. E.g. <math>1300-50</math>, <math>1000+250</math>, <math>3750/3</math>. <b>(IN)</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Friday</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Write down all the letters of the alphabet that feature a right angle. Use capital block letters to spell out your name. How many right angles did you find? <b>(IN)</b></li> <li>○ Watch this <a href="#">dance video</a>. Follow along and have a play with position. <b>(IN)</b></li> </ul> <div style="text-align: center; margin-top: 10px;"> </div>	<p>Fill OR copy the chart on Google Classroom.
