(IN) Steps Cut out the head, stem and leaves of the flower. Cut out the long strips for the petals. Join the ends of the strips together to make a circle (petal). Stick the petals on the head of the flower. Stick the stem on. Stick the head of the flower on with its petal Stick the leaves on, fold the top of the leaves up so they look 3D.
