# YEAR 3 2020 TERM 1 OVERVIEW

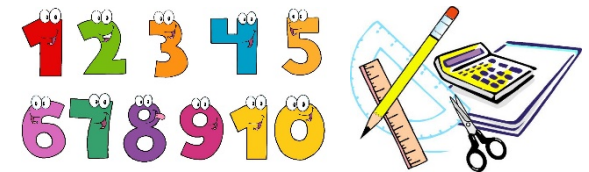
## PDHPE

In PDHPE, students will learn to explain how empathy, inclusion and respect can positively influence relationships. They will also practise skills to promote inclusion and ensure that all students feel as they belong.



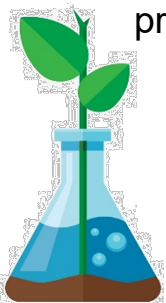
# MATHEMATICS

Students will be exploring the topics of whole number concepts such as rounding, partitioning and comparing numbers, and using a variety of addition and subtraction strategies such as the compensation and algorithms. Students will also focus on using and collecting data and finish the term exploring the measurement strand of area.



## SCIENCE

Students will be exploring the Living World strand of Science and will gain a deeper understanding of the agricultural processes that are used to grow plants and raise animals for clothing, food and shelter. In addition to this, they will be taking parts in scientific experiments and challenges.



## CAPA

Students will be taking part in Visual Arts lessons. They will be focusing on different artists, styles and features from around the world. In addition to this, they will be creating a series of different mediums of art works using a variety of materials.



## HISTORY

Students will be exploring the First Contacts of Australia as part of their History unit. They will learn to describe what life was like for the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People during the British colonisation of Australia and the journeys taken by settlers of Australia.
