ENGLISH

In English, students will be focusing on imaginative writing, in particular using literary devices and sentence structure to enhance the quality of their writing. During the term, they will also be taking part in a poetry unit concentrating on the concepts of connotation, imagery and symbol within the texts. In addition to this, students will be exposed to various opportunities to enhance their speaking and listening skills.



SCIENCE

Students will be exploring the Material World strand of science and will gain a deeper understanding of the properties of natural and processed materials and how materials can be used sustainably. In addition to this, they will be taking part in scientific experiments and design and make challenges to enhance their understanding of the content.



YEAR 4 2020 TERM 4 OVERVIEW

PDHPE

In PDHPE, students will be exploring the benefits of physical activity on the human body. They will be learning about actions to enhance their own wellbeing, safe ways to be active and skills to be healthy. In addition to this, students will be taking part in sport lessons developing and applying their fundamental movement skills to games.



CAPA

This term students will be taking part in music lessons. They will explore the concepts of music such as pitch, tone, rhythm and dynamics. Students will develop performance skills through a range of practical experiences that encourage collaboration and an experimentation with music composition.



MATHEMATICS

In mathematics, students will be revising the concepts of fractions and decimals. They will then learn about using and interpreting data

from graphs, tables and surveys. In the measurement strand, students will be focusing on the identification and sketching of threedimensional objects, as well as using twodimensional shapes to make symmetrical patterns by sliding, flipping and turning them.



GEOGRAPHY

Students will be focusing on the Earth's environment as part of their geography unit. They will investigate the ways people, places and environments interact in particular throughout the Asian region. Throughout the unit, students will utilise the geographic tools of inquiry to gain deeper understanding of the

content.
