Principal's Message

SUMMER HOLIDAYS

Last day for students is Wednesday 19 December 2018.

SCHOOL RESUMES

Students in Years 1-6 resume on Wednesday 30 January 2019. Kindergarten begins Monday 4 February 2019, please see Best Start times for the week proceeding.

EXTREME WEATHER

Sydney experienced some extreme weather conditions in the last two weeks, with fierce winds and dust storms followed by severe rainstoms. In such circumstances be assured the welfare of our students and staff is paramount. We assess the conditions outside and make a decision to either keep students indoors or allow them to play outdoors in safe areas of the school. This is exactly what has occurred over last two weeks.

CLASS STRUCTURES 2019

Currently our school numbers are changing on a daily basis as we confirm families leaving and new enrolments K-6. At this point in time, no final decisions regarding class structures have been confirmed as enrolment numbers change on a daily basis, however we are anticipating the establishment of 34 classes with 35 being a distinct possibility. At present the class structure necessitate the formation of a composite Year 1 and 2 class.

If you are aware that your circumstances have changed and you will not be joining us for the 2019 school year could I please request that you contact the school office **this week** to inform them of your changing circumstance. It is vitally important that we are aware of any students who may not be returning to Parramatta West. Your support in keeping us informed is greatly appreciated. Also, please advise us in writing, if your child/ren will be late to start the new school year.

If you have any questions regarding class structure for 2019 please don't hesitate to contact me.

SEMESTER 2 REPORTS

Our teachers are currently preparing to write end of year reports for students. These will be available for all parents prior to the end of the school year. Parents who wish to speak directly with the class teacher regarding their child's progress before the end of the year are welcomed to make contact to schedule a mutually agreeable time.

SWIMMING SCHOOL

This very worthwhile program began last week. Ten days of intensive tuition is extremely effective in improving students' swimming skills. Further it begins to teach students important life skills such as independence and responsibility. Please allow your children to practice skills such as towel drying themselves, getting dressed independently, brushing their own hair and packing their own bag. I expect that these students have and will continue to sleep very well over the next two week period. Many thanks to our coordinating teachers and the teachers who have volunteered to get in the pool with our students.

STUDENT ABSENCES

Regular attendance at school is essential if students are to maximise their potential. Parramatta West P.S., in partnership with parent/caregivers, promotes the regular, punctual attendance of students. While parents are legally responsible for the regular attendance of their children, school staff, as part of their duty of care, monitor part or whole day absences.

Parents are responsible for:

- Ensuring that their children attend school regularly
- Explaining the absence of their children from school promptly and within seven days to the school

If an absence has not been explained after a period of seven days has elapsed, the absence may be deemed 'unexplained – unjustified.' Even if an explanation is received after seven days have elapsed from the students return to school, the record showing 'unjustified' for the absence may not be able to be adjusted.

The Department of Education directs schools to monitor and account for the arrival and departure time of students each day while recognising that absence or lateness may occur due to:

- illness
- misadventure or unforeseen event
- domestic necessity such as the serious illness of an immediate family member
- attendance at funerals
- recognised religious festivals or ceremonial occasions

Please be aware that the Department of Education advises schools that 'running late' or 'slept in' are not considered to be acceptable explanations of lateness and the partial absence will be recorded as 'unjustified.'
